A warm welcome to Jim Trapnell who once again returned to cook and serve at MUST after a brief illness (Jim has just received an award for serving 15+ years on the Rotary MUST team and celebrated his 91st birthday), accompanied by his enthusiasm, volunteering spirit, and leaping right back to assist in preparing lunch for 90+ residents at MUST Ministry for the final luncheon of 2019. Chef Harold Hobbs, Adam Hobbs, Jim Trapnell, Marlys Williams, and Morgan Robertson bustled around to produce perhaps the best entrée of the year, Chicken Pot Pie with Biscuit Topping. Ingredients for the entrée included 9 quart cans of chicken breasts, 14 cans of English peas, 14 cans of canned corn, 12 cans cream of mushroom soup, 1 large tub sour cream, 1 gallon of milk, 5 pounds of shredded cheddar cheese, with biscuit topping.
